Banknotes are dispensed from the note recycling device in parallel and a receipt is printed. All activities are registered in the Orchard J software and can be sent via the monitoring software to a central server.

Maximum cash flow control

During the day, the RCS 400 also serves as a continuous cash supplier, enabling a supervisor to support cashiers with change when needed.

At the end of the day, the cashier logs on and quickly deposits coins and notes from the day's takings.

The coins and notes are safely stored in dispensers, ready for future float dispensing. The notes can be stored in the recycling device for future float dispense or sent to the self sealing bag.


